

APICS NYC-LI Chapter Annual Scholarship 2017

The APICS NYC-LI Chapter will be awarding two (2) scholarships for tuition reimbursement in the amount of \$1,000 to an undergraduate or graduate students interested in pursuing a career in supply chain or logistics management. The purpose of this program is to further APICS and APICS NYC-LI educational goals while supporting the academic development of students seeking a career in supply chain management.

Eligibility & Requirements

Eligibility:

Any undergraduate or graduate student attending a University or College in within the area served by the APICS NYC-LI chapter, which includes the five boroughs of New York City and Nassau and Suffolk counties on Long Island.

Requirements:

- Pursuing a major, minor, or concentration in logistics, supply chain or a related field or planning to pursue a career in supply chain management
- Anticipated date of graduation is after September 2017
- Must be a student in good standing or higher (through end of most recent semester)
- Must be a member of an APICS Student Chapter at their college or university
- Completed Application Form and Essay (see Application Form)
- One letter of Reference from a Professor at your University or College
- Original Transcript through end of most recent semester

Application & Essay Requirements

Essay Requirements

Submit a typed, double spaced, 500 word essay responding to the following topic:

Topic 1

“Discuss the supply chain challenges and opportunities in simultaneously trading with Great Britain and European Union countries post Brexit for companies outside the European Union.”

Topic 2

“What supply chain strategies are needed to address the challenges of e-commerce and omnichannel marketing in the next five years?”

Topic 3

“What are some of the differences between operating public and private sector supply chains and what lessons can public sector supply chains learn from the private sector?”
