



Your visit to the premises of the New York City Transit Authority may involve entry upon certain areas of the Authority's system which are being used for operating purposes. Trains will continue to operate in these areas and their electric power traction system (the "third rail") will remain on or "live". Because we cannot discontinue operations during the period of your visit and because of the nature of the risk of your person, we ask that you execute this Visitor's Release Form prior to the commencement of your visit. Absent execution of the release, you will not be permitted to enter upon Authority property.

VISITOR'S RELEASE

The undersigned (the "visitor") in consideration of being permitted for the visitor's own purposes to enter upon the premises of the New York City Transit Authority, hereby assumes all risk of accident and all risk of personal injury to the visitor (including death) and damage to his or her personal property, sustained while on, at or about such premises, and for the visitor, the visitor's heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives and assigns, hereby release The City of New York, Metropolitan Transportation Authority, and New York City Transit Authority, and their respective members, officers, agents and employees, from any and all liability whatsoever for any loss, personal injury (including death) or property damage which may be suffered by the visitor while on, at or about the premises of the New York City Transit Authority, irrespective of whether such loss, injury or damage shall have been due to the negligence of The City of New York, Metropolitan Transportation Authority, and New York City Transit Authority, or their respective members, officers, agents or employees, or otherwise.

The undersigned further hereby agrees to hold harmless and indemnify The City of New York, Metropolitan Transportation Authority New York City Transit Authority, and their respective members, officers, agents and employees, from any and all loss and liability for damages on account of injuries (including death) to persons and damage to property attributable in whole or in part to the negligence of the undersigned while on, or about the premises of the New York City Transit Authority.
